This Indenture made the thirteenth day of October in the year of our Lord
one thousand seven hundred and Eighty six and in the Eleventh year of the Independence of
the United States of America Between Kenner Hudson of Greenville County and State of
South Carolina planter of the one part and Hance Black of the County and Province
aforesaid planter of the other part Whereas in and by a certain Grant bearing date
the fifteenth day of October one thousand Seven hundred and Eighty four and in the
Ninth year of the Independence of the United States of America aforesaid under the hand
and Seal of Benjamin Querard Esquire Governor and Commander in Chief of the said
State and the great Seal of the said State for that purpose appointed did give and
Grant unto the said Kenner Hudson a plantation or tract of two hundred acres of
Land situate lying and being on the Waters of Reedy River South side bounding
on all sides on vacant land and hath such shape form and marks as appears to a plat
thereof to the said Grant annexed as in and by the said plat and grant duly Recorded
in the Secretarys Office of the said province Reference being thereto had may
more fully appear Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Kenner
Hudson for and in Consideration of the sum of twenty pounds Sterling to him in
hand paid by the said Hance Black the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
to the said Kenner Hudson hath bargained sold Remised Conveyed and Confirmed and
by these presents do grant bargain sell alien Remise Release Convey and Con-
firm unto the said Hance Black in his actual possession now being by Vir-
tue of a bargain and sale to him therof made for one whole year and by force of
