This Indenture Made the Eighth day of December in the year one  
Thousand Seven hundred and Eighty five and in the tenth year of American  
Independence Between James W. Williams of the State of South Carolina  
Lawrence County planter of the one part and Lazarus Summerlin of the  
County and State aforesaid planter of the other part Witnesseth that the said  
James W. Williams for and in Consideration of the sum of twenty Eight  
Pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the said Lazarus Summerlin the  
Receipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged he the said James W. Williams  
hath Bargained and Sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell all  
that Plantation or tract of two hundred acres of land being part of a tract of  
six hundred and forty acres granted unto the said James W. Williams  
by a patent bearing date the twenty first day of January one thousand Seven hun-  
dred and Eighty five lying on Reedy River above the antient boundary line boun-  
ded North on John Browns land E on Hugh Pork's land West on Mathew  
Armstrong's land all Containing two hundred acres be the same more or less  
laid together with all and singular the Houses, Edifices, out houses, Orchards,  
Trees, Woods, underwoods, Ways, Waters, Watercourses, Hereditaments, and Appur-  
tenances, as also the Revision, and Reversions, and Remainders, Rents, Issues,  
and Profits and Every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said  
Plantation or tract of two hundred acres of land with all and singular the Her-  
editaments and Appurtenances therunto belonging to the only proper use and be-  
sides of him the said Lazarus Summerlin his heirs and assigns for and during  
the full End and term of one whole year from thence Ensuing and full to be Compleas  
and Ended yielding and paying unto the said James W. Williams on the last day  
of the said term one peper Com if the same Should be lawfully demanded to the intent  
and purpose and by Virtue of the Statute for transferring uses into possession the  
said Lazarus Summerlin may be in Actual possession of all and singular the  
Hereditaments, and appurtenances therunto belonging and be thereby the better  
Enabled to have take and Receive the Revision and inheritance thereof  
which is intended to be made to the said Lazarus Summerlin his heirs and assigns  
forever by another Indenture dated the day next after the day of the date of these pre-  
sents in Wherof the said James W. Williams hath hereunto set his hand  
and seal the day and year above written, Also Rosannah W. Williams wife of the  
said James W. Williams in testimony of her Consent to the sale also hath set her  
hand and Seal,
