other part witnesseth that the said Benjamin Rice for and in con-
sideration of the sum of twenty Shillings Sterling money to him in
hand well and truly paid by the said Edmund Edwards at and before the
sealing and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby ac-
knowledged he the said Benjamin Rice hath Bargained and sold and by the
Presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Edmund Edwards all that
Plantation or tract of Land containing Seventy and three acres more
or less being and lying in the County aforesaid on the waters of the
Golden Grove Creek a Branch of Saluda River it being part of a tract of
Land containing four Hundred acres granted unto the said Benjamin
Rice by his Excellency Benjamin Guard Esq; Governor and Comman-
