

20 James M^cEbroy hath hereby bargained sold & conveyed unto the s^r Ezechiah Cottens a certain Tract or parcel of Land containing three hundred and thirty one acres situate in the County of Greenville on the North side of Teedy River on both sides of Saunders branch being a Tract of land Granted to the s^r James M^cEbroy on the fifteenth day of October one thousand seven hundred & eighty four by his Excellency Benjamin Guard Esq^r Governor & commander in chief it begining at a pine corner on William Youngs Tuning north 20 East 59 & ten links to a post Oak corner thence North 65 West 59 chain & ten links to a hycory corner thence South 29 West 92 chain to a post Oak station thence south 54 East 60 chain to the begining together with all & singular the woods waters water-courses profits commodities hereditaments & appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining to have & to hold the s^r Tract of land containing three hundred and thirty one acres hereby Granted & sold with their & every of their appurtenances unto the said Ezechiah Cottens his heirs & assigns for ever and the said James M^cEbroy for himself his heirs &c^{et al.} & assigns the s^r hereby Granted premises with their appurtenances unto the s^r Ezechiah Cottens his heirs & assigns against the claim or claims of any other person or persons whatsoever shall & warrant & for ever defend by these presents In witness whereof the s^r James M^cEbroy hath hereunto set his hand & seal the day & date first above written Signed Sealed & Delivered } James M^cEbroy his M^cMark J.P.
