

The following deed of Conveyance from Thomas Lewis to John Thomas was produced in Open Court July Term 1791 & proven before John Alexander Esq. and Ordered to be read which was done this 3rd day of August 1791.

This Indenture made the sixth day of March one thousand seven hundred and Ninety and of the Independence of the united states of America the fourteenth between Thomas Lewis of the state of South Carolina and County of Greenville of the one part and John Thomas of the State & County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds in hand paid by the said John Thomas the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Thomas Lewis hath granted bargained and sold aliened conveyed & confirmed and by these presents doth Grant bargain & sell alien convey & confirm unto the said John Thomas his heirs & assigns for ever all that plantation or Tract of Land containing three hundred acres beginning at a Red oak & running thence N. 80° E. 80 chains to Skycory & thence S. 89° 11' chains to stake & thence S. 15° 24' to stake & thence on chandlers line S. 87° 5' - 22' Chains to stake & thence S. 74° 61' - 78 ch. to stake & thence N. 79° 29' Chains to the beginning being part of a Tract of 640 acres of Land Originally Granted to the said Thomas Lewis on the 16th day of July 1784 Recorded in the Sutters Office in Grant Book L. L. L. page 65 Reference being thereunto had may more fully appear situate in the County aforesaid on Horse Creek of Yeogy River Together with all and singular the houses Trees woods under woods waters & water Courses profits commodities advantages heridaments ways & Appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining and also the Reversion or reversions, Remainder & Remainders with Issues & profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof and also all the Estate Right Title Interest Claim or Demand whatsoever of him the s^d. Thomas Lewis either in law or equity of in or to the said plantation or Tract of three
