Carolina my true & lawful attorney to sell dispose of Convey to any
purchaser or purchasers a tract of one thousand acres of land or any
part thereof Situate in Greenville County & State of S. Carolina on
both sides of Reedy Fork of Reedy River bounded Northwardly on George
Martins land Eastwardly on William Woods land & Southwardly on
S^d Maximilian Conner's land ratifying & confirming whatsoever
my s^d Attorney may do concerning the premises as much as if I
were personally present & to sign conveyances in my name for the same
or any part thereof with power of substitution In witness whereof
the S^d Maximilian Conner has hereunto set my hand and
affixed my seal the tenth day of February one thousand seven
hundred and Ninety four

15 The following Deed of Conveyance from James Vernon to Elisha Duv^r
ee being proven before Joseph Dunklin Esq^r by the oath of Peyton
Newlin was presented & Recorded this 14th day of January 1795
This instrument made this tenth day of August one thousand seven
hundred & Ninety three & in the seventeenth year of American's Indepen-
dence between James Vernon of the State of South Carolina & Ninety
six District of the one part & Elisha Duvore of the S^d State of Washington
District of the other part Witnesseth that the S^d James Vernon for in
consideration of the sum of two hundred pounds Sterling money to
him in hand paid by the S^d Elisha Duvore at & before the sealing & delivery
of these presents the receipt whereof be the S^d James Vernon doth
hereby acknowledge & from every part & panel thereof do acquit and
discharge the S^d Elisha Duvore him & his heirs & assigns & for divers
other good causes & considerations hereunto moving have granted
bargained sold aliened Enseoffed & confirmed & by these presents
do grant bargain enseoff & confirm unto him the S^d Elisha Duvore
his heirs & assigns for ever part of plantation or tract of land lying
being in the District of Washington & Greenville County on Reedy
River Originally Granted to Alexander Vernon on the twenty first day
of January anno Domini one thousand seven hundred Eighty five
as by a plot hereunto annexed will fully appear begining on a red oak
at thence N 60 E 7.00 to red oak at thence S 30 E 19.80 to a hickory & Joh
Camp's land, thence N 60 E 44.75 to a post oak at Hewitt Sullivan's land
thence N 10 W 7.75 to a stake at Charles Sullivan's land thence S 75 E
