 part & parcel thereof do acquit & discharge the S<sup>r</sup>. James Samford his heirs  
 and assigns, have granted bargained sold and confirmed & by these presents  
 do grant bargain sell alien enfeoff & confirm unto the S<sup>r</sup>. James Samford his  
 heirs and assigns for ever one hundred acres of land lying in Greenville Coun-  
 ty on the little fork of Reedy River being part of a Tract of five hundred acres of  
 Land Originally Granted to Robert Gilman Wigned by his Excellency Thomas  
 Pinckney on the seventh day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand  
 seven hundred & Eighty eight & in the twelfth year of the Independance of  
 America as by a plat annexed to the said Grant will more fully appear being  
 laid out unto the S<sup>r</sup>. James Samford as follows beginning on a black oak corner  
 of the Original line on the north side of the S<sup>r</sup>. little fork of Reedy River and  
 running N 62 E 16 chains to a corner on a stake thence running N 28 E 67 chains  
 to a stake corner on the Original line thence running S 62 E 15 chains on  
 the S<sup>r</sup>. Original line to a post oak corner from thence running S 28 W 67 cha-  
 ins on the S<sup>r</sup>. line to the beginning including one hundred acres of land  
 Together with all & singular the houses out Houses ways waters paths  
 passages trees Fences easements hereditaments & appurtenances whatsoever  
 to the S<sup>r</sup>. tract of land so described as above belonging or in any wise appur-  
 taining and the reversion & Reversions Remainder & Remainders rents  
 Issues & profits thereof & every part & parcel thereof & all the estate right
