 next before the day of the date hereof and sealed and delivered before the Ex-
 ercising of these presents and also by force of the Statute for transferring of
 uses into possession in that case made and provided and unto his heirs and
 assigns for ever All that parcel or tract of land lying and being in

 nally granted to Thomas Atkins containing Elorn thousand five hundred
 and fifty acres more or less as the original plat and grant thereof now of
 record in the secretaries Office of Charlestown will appear and which was con-
