

The following deed of Conveyance from Robert Goodlett to William Grant  
 being proven before Reuben Barrett Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of Thomas M Grew  
 was presented and recorded this 13<sup>th</sup> day of April AD 1796

This Indenture made this twenty fourth day of September in the year of our  
 Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six, and in the twentieth year of  
 the American Independence between Rob<sup>t</sup> Goodlett of the State of S<sup>t</sup> Carolina Wash-  
 ington District &c of Greenville of the one part, & W<sup>m</sup> Grant of the State District  
 &c aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that for & in consideration of the sum  
 of twelve pounds Sterling Money to the said Rob<sup>t</sup> Goodlett in hand well and  
 truly paid by the s<sup>r</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Grant at or before the sealing & delivery of these pre-  
 sent<sup>s</sup> the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold aliened  
 conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien  
 convey and confirm unto the said William Grant a certain piece of land  
 containing by estimation Twenty six acres the same being apart of the  
 plantation or tract of Land now in the possession of the afores<sup>d</sup> Rob<sup>t</sup> Goodlett  
 begining on a post oak on W<sup>m</sup> Benson's corner line the north side of the S<sup>c</sup>  
 fork of the three forks of S<sup>t</sup> Tyger River, thence S<sup>c</sup> 44 W to a post oak Goodlett's  
 corner &c thence S 11<sup>o</sup> E to a slate & pointed 14-75, thence N<sup>c</sup> 20<sup>o</sup> 48' E to the  
 begining being as is above mentioned by estimation Twenty six acres of s<sup>r</sup>  
 Robert Goodlett's Tract of Land together with all and singular the Gardens  
 ways wells waters water courses woods under woods emoluments easements  
 profits commodities hereditaments & appurtenances whatsoever to the same  
 belonging or in any wise appertaining, and the reversion & Reversions,  
 remainder and rents & issues & profits thereunto belonging to have & to hold  
 the lands hereby conveyed, and all and singular the premises hereby bar-  
 gained held unto the s<sup>r</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Grant his heirs Exec<sup>t</sup> Adm<sup>r</sup> & assigns for ever  
 and to the only proper use & behoof of him the s<sup>r</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Grant his heirs Exec<sup>t</sup>  
 Adm<sup>r</sup> & assigns from him the s<sup>r</sup> Robert Goodlett his heirs Exec<sup>t</sup> Adm<sup>r</sup> & assigns &  
 from every other person or persons whatsoever & for the better further better & more  
 perfect conveying and assuring the premises afores<sup>d</sup> with appurtenances unto  
 the s<sup>r</sup> William Grant his heirs or assigns or his or their Counsel Learned in the law  
 shall be reasonably advised devised or required In witness whereof the s<sup>r</sup>  
 Rob<sup>t</sup> Goodlett his heirs Exec<sup>t</sup> Adm<sup>r</sup> and assigns doth warrant & for ever defend  
 the aforesaid Land and premises from all and every other person or persons  
 laying any right title property Interest claim or demand to the s<sup>r</sup> Land &  
 premises thereunto justly In witness whereof the s<sup>r</sup> Rob<sup>t</sup> Goodlett hath here-  
 unto set his hand and affixed his seal the day & date first above written
