being proven before John McElroy Esq^r by the oath of John White
was presented and Recorded this 26th day of April AD 1796
This Indenture made this twenty first day of January in the year of our
Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety six between James Ward of the
County of Greenville and State of South Carolina of the one part & James West of
the County & State aforesaid of the other part, witnesseth that the said James
Ward for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds Sterling
Money to him in hand paid by the said James West before the sealing & delivery
of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged & him these^d James
Ward hath granted bargained sold aliened Enseoff Released & confirmed &
by these presents doth grant bargain sell Enseoff Release and confirm unto
the said James West his heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel of land
lying and being in the County & State aforesaid on the waters of the golden grove
Creek bounded on land laid out to the Honorable Henry Pendleton also on lands
of John Bowie containing one hundred & forty nine acres Originally granted to
Thomas Farrar by his Excellency Benjamin Gerard on the twenty fourth day
of September one thousand seven hundred and eighty four which tract of land
has been conveyed by the said Thomas Farrar to the above mentioned Robert
Gilliland Jun^r & Recorded by Order of the Honourable Court of Greenville October
Term 1791 in Book C page 55 which will fully appear by Reference to S^d Recd
beginning at Red oak thence S 25 W 55 to a Red oak thence S 45 E 27-10 to a stake, thence
N 45 E 55 to a stake, thence N 45 W 27-10 to the beginning together with all Buildings
gardens orchards edifices woods timber meadows ways waters passages piers bridges
profits habitaments rights & appurtenances thereunto belonging & the reversions
Remainders & Remainders rents & profits thereof & every part & parcel thereof & all the
estates rights titles claims and demands whatsoever unto the S^d James West & his
heirs and assigns for ever unto the only proper use & behoof of him the S^d James West his
heirs and assigns to have & to hold the S^d grant of land & premises from all former
Sales gifts mortgages rights of dower or any other Incumbrance whatsoever the
S^d James Ward for himself his heirs & assigns doth Covenant & agree to & with
the S^d James West his heirs and assigns that they shall & may at all times hereafter
hold, use, occupy & possess the above mentioned land & premises without the least hin-
drance of him the S^d James Ward his heirs and assigns the S^d granted land & premises
unto the said James West his heirs & assigns shall and will warrant & by these presents
for ever defend unto the S^d James West his heirs & assigns in witness whereof the S^d James Ward
hath hereunto set his hand & seal the day and date first above written

252 The following Mortgage from Lewis Williams to John Swaring being proven
before Humphrey Cobb Esq^r by the oath of Drury Morris was presented and
Recorded this 26th day of April AD 1796.

This Indenture made the thirty first day of March one thousand seven hundred &
ninety six between Lewis Williams of Greenville County South Carolina of the one part
& John Swaring of the County & State aforesaid of the other part, witnesseth that the
S^d Lewis Williams for and in consideration of the sum of ninety six pounds Sterling
to him in hand paid by the S^d John Swaring the receipt whereof the said Lewis
Williams doth hereby acknowledge he the S^d Lewis Williams hath granted bar-
gained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto the said
