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The following Deed of Conveyance from James Powell to Elisabeth Mat-  
thews being proven before Horatio Griffin Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of Benjamin  
Griffith was presented and recorded this 10<sup>th</sup> June 1797

State of South Carolina, I know all men by these presents that I James  
Powell of Laurens County & State aforesaid for and in consideration of the  
sum of Eight dollars to me paid by Elisabeth Matthews of Greenville County  
and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by  
these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Elisabeth Mat-  
thews apart of a Tract of land Originally granted to the s<sup>d</sup> James Powell in  
Greenville County which land the said Elisabeth Matthews now lives on be-  
ginning at a Stake in the Original line S W 20 and corner to a Stake it being  
the Original corner, thence with the Original line S E 54 and corner to a  
Stake in the Original line thence to the begining including one hundred acres  
together with the improvements she now lives on together with all & singular  
the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the sd premises  
belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining to have and to hold  
all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the s<sup>d</sup> Elisabeth Mat-  
thews her heirs and assigns for ever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs  
Exec<sup>d</sup> Adm<sup>r</sup> to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the sd premises  
unto the s<sup>d</sup> Elisabeth Matthews her heirs & assigns against myself my heirs  
but them only as witness my hand this 26 day of January one thousand hun-  
dred and ninety seven
