aforesaid have granted bargained and sold and released and by these presents
do grant bargain sell and release unto Baylis Earle all that tract or parcel
of land as is hereafter described begining at a post oak corner running thence
N 58 7 ch^s to a red oak, thence N 30 W 47 ch^s and 50 links crossing two bran-
ches to a red oak thence S. 40 W 92 ch^s crossing brush Creek adarter of Ready River
to a Spanish oak thence S. 30 E 10 ch^s to a Spanish oak, thence S. 68 62 ch^s &
50 links crossing Brush Creek to the begining containing one hundred & one
acres by the same more or less together with all and singular the rights members
