to me paid by George Allin of Greenville County have granted bargained sold  
and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the  
said George Allin a plantation or tract of land laying and being in Greenville  
County on the waters of South Tigar river begining at a post oak growing thereon  
N<sup>o</sup> 55 E. 34 ch<sup>r</sup> to a pine (widow Smith's line) thence with her line N<sup>o</sup> 69 ch<sup>r</sup> to  
a stake, thence S<sup>o</sup> 76 W. 47 ch<sup>r</sup> to a pine, thence N<sup>o</sup> 56 9 ch<sup>r</sup> to a stake (on Nelson's  
line) thence with his line E. 15 ch<sup>r</sup> to a stake his corner, thence S<sup>o</sup> to the begin-  
ning containing by estimation two hundred and Twenty two acres to the  
same more or less the same being part of a tract of land granted to me  
by patent bearing date 5<sup>th</sup> day of June 1786 including the Improvement  
made by Joshua King & Charles Angle together with all and singular the  
rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises  
belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all and  
singular the premises before mentioned to the said George Allin his
