In consideration of the sum of One hundred Dollars to me paid by  
Reuben Martin of the County & State afores<sup>d</sup> I have granted Bar-  
gained Sold & Released by these presents do Grant Bargain sold  
& Release unto the sd. Rubin Martin a certain tract of parcell  
of land containing One hundred Ares More or less Situated  
in the County & State afores<sup>d</sup> on the Branches of Armstrong  
Creek being part of two tracts of Land Originally Granted to  
sd. William Martin being upon a post oak corner running the  
Original line to a stake upon a conditional line between  
sd. William Martin & John B. Blackwell thence the condition-  
al line to a white Oak upon the Original line thence the origi-  
nal line to a branch thence a conditional line to Blackwells  
Spring Branch thence Down thence Branch to the Original  
line thence the Original line to the beginning Together with  
all & Singular the rights members hereditaments &  
appertaining to the sd. premises belonging or in any wise  
incident or appertaining to have & to hold all & Singular  
the premises before mention unto the sd. Reuben Martin his  
Heirs & assigns for Ever & I do here bind myself my heirs  
executors Administrators to warrant & for Ever defend & alle-  
& singular the sd. premises unto the sd. Rubin Martin his heirs  
& assigns against my self my heirs & against Every other  
person who ever lawfully claiming or to claim the same  
or any part thereof witness my hand & seal this 5<sup>th</sup> day of  
May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety  
Eight & in the 22<sup>nd</sup> year of the independence of the United state  
of America

me presented and Recorded this 1<sup>st</sup> Day of August 1798  
and made this fifteenth day of August in the year of our Lord

sd. Edward Mitcheson the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the  
said William Mitcheson hath bargained & sold & by these presents  
doth Bargain sell all in one acre Conform unto Edward Mitcheson all  
that tract or Parcell of land containing fifty acres situate in greenville  
County on Both sides of Peters Creek waters of Cimore River Bound-  
ing on the West side of the ancient Boundary Indian line, on the  
South by John Mitcheson Land on the East by Levy Morris Land,  
Granted to Archer Thims and on the West side by Isaac Towns  
Land and the said William Mitcheson for himself his Heirs  
Executors and adm<sup>t</sup> doth Covenant and agree to & with the  
said Edward Mitcheson time he his Heirs Executors adm<sup>t</sup>  
and affirms that the above described Land is free and clear from  
any & Manner of incumbrance What so ever & that the sd. Edward  
Mitcheson his Heirs Executors adm<sup>t</sup> or affirms May at any  
time here after and at all time peaceably Possess occupy & enjoy  
the above Described fifty acres of Land with all its appurtenances rents  
Profits & dues hereditaments Commodities Edifice buildings Barns  
Houses out Houses Pechado trees Woods under woods & any  
Water Courses whatsoever there unto belonging or in any wise ap-  
pertaining there unto without any denial of him the said  
William Mitcheson his Heirs Executors Administrators or affirms  
or any other Person or Persons whatsoever laying any just or lawfull  
Right title or claim there unto or any part thereof. But will forever  
Marry and Defend the above Described Land from himself his Heirs  
Executors adm<sup>t</sup> & affirms or any other person or Person whatsoever  
and to the only proper use & Benefit of him the said Edward Mit-  
cheson he his Heirs Executors Administrators or affirms in Witness  
where of the said William Mitcheson hath hereunto set his hand  
and affixed his Seal the Day & Date first above written signed sealed  
and Delivered in Presence of
