This Indenture made this fifteenth of December in the year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven Between Richard Steagall of Greenville County & State of S^t Carolina of the one part & Thomas McGrew of our said County & State of the other part witnesseth That the sd Richard Steagall for divers goods & causes himself herein to make but more especially for & in consideration of the just and full sum of three hundred and forty Dollars in hand well & truly paid at & before the insealing & Delivering of this presentee have Bargained sold & Delivered and by these presents do freely bargain sell & Deliver to Thomas McGrew his heirs & assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in Greenville County containing fifty acres be the same more or less bounded so followeth on Both sides of Checharoa River of Saluda being part of a tract of Land granted unto Baily Anderson bounded southwest upon Samuel Aggett's open line & last open abounding line made between the foresaid Baily Anderson & Jonathan Majich the aforesaid Jonathan Majich's Land Being part of the same tract and on all other sides by land unknown with all the water water Crops orchards houses fence gardens and all the improvements thereon being to have and hold the sd. Bargainer premises and all & every part thereof unto the sd. Thomas McGrew his Heirs and assigns forever these fifty acres of land be the sum more or less to enjoy possess & occupy without any manner of let trouble molestation or denial of him the sd. Richd. Duncan all that tract of land that was granted to James McElroy by his Excellency Benjamin Guard Esq^r containing three hundred & thirty one acres as by the Plat will more fully appear Excepting one hundred acres sold to Alexander West & one hundred to William Duncan grant bearing date the fifteenth of October 1785 & Recorded in Secretary's office grant Book L L Page 240 also part of one other tract granted B. Thos.
