47 The following Deed of conveyance from James Alexandria to Andrew Cooper being proven before David Goodlett Esq^r by the oath of John Alexander was presented and recorded this 10th Day of August 1798 This Indenture made this the first Day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety eight and in the twenty third year of American Independency between James Alexandria Planter of the State of South Carolina and Greenville County of the one part and Andrew Cooper Carpenter of the estate and County aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said James Alexandria for and Consideration of the sum of one Hundred Pounds Lawfull Money of the state of South Carolina to him in hand paid by the said Andrew Cooper at & before the sealing and Delivering of these presents (the receipt whereof is here by acknowledged) have granted bargained all and Released and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant Bargain Sell alien Release and confirm unto the said Andrew Cooper In his actual Possession now being by virtue of a bargain and seal to him there made forever all that Plantation tract or Parc of Land containing two hundred acres be the same more or less it being one half of that P^r tract of land originally granted to William Henderson and duly conveyed by him to S^r James Alexander it being the North West half of said tract of land Beginning at a red oak and running S 10 W 63 24 to a Stake thence S 80 E 31 62 to a red oak thence N 10 E 63 24 to a white oak thence N 80 W 31 62 to the beginning situate on branchs

of Baglins Creek about Two Miles from the Indian boundary and hath such ~~size~~ shapes and marks as the original Plat represents granted by his Excellency Benjamin Gerard Esquire Governor and Commander in chief in and over S^r State at Charleston the Patent Baring date the Twenty first Day of January in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven hundred and Eighty five, and in the Ninth year of the Independence of the United States of America ~~Indep~~
