Gray Esq^r by the oath of Daniel Ford was presented and recorded this 19th day of April 1799 State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Graham Kelly of Greenville County in the state aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds Sterling paid to me in hand by Thomas Serry of the County and State aforesaid and have granted Bargain sold and Released By these presents to said Serry all that tract of Land or plantation lying on the North side of the fork theals of Rudy River beginning at a hickory on the rear runs seventeen chains on Bakers line P. oak from thence S. thirty three chains to water oak from thence up the river to the Beginning together with all singular lights number heridaments appertaining to have to hold all singular Premises Before mentioned unto the said Serry his heirs and assigns forever I do hereby Bind myself my heirs and assigns forever to do hereby Bind myself my heirs and assigns administrators to warrant and forever defend the said Land to the said Serry his heirs assigns ^{et cetera} against myself my heirs and against every person that sower lawfully claiming or to claim the same
