West Henry Burrow N. W. on Benjamin Townen's L. C. and Thomas Capps together with all and singular houses building Rights and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining to or with the said tract of Sixty five acres of Land with the Reversions and Rents remainder and remainders rents uses & profits there of unto the said James Mullins his heirs Executors and Administrators and assigns to have and to hold the said tract of Land with its premises and appurtenances unto the said James Mullins his heirs and assigns to the only purpose and behoof of him the said James Mullins his heirs and assigns forever and the said David Ridgway doth for himself his heirs &c forever dispend from him for no other purpose whereof the said David Ridgway hath been unto set his seal the day and year first above written signed sealed and delivered in presence of Henry Burrow & James Holland
