July 5th Anno thousand seven hundred and ninety nine Know all men by these presents that I William Stringer of the state aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to me paid by Benjamin Meritt of the County of Greenville have granted Bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant Bargain sell and release unto the said Benjamin Meritt part of a tract of land lying and being in the County aforesaid and being on the branches of the North fork of Saluda River beginning at a white oak on Thomas Farrows line running N. 50^W 20 chain and fifty links to a Red oak N 12^E chain to a pine 460 E 23 chain & fifty links to a hickory N 15^E to a gum station from thence running a direct course on the top of the saddle mountain to the fork of Wheaton Meritts Branch thence a straight line to the top of lawn house oak and then to a line in the gap of the Mountain from thence to a stake & from thence to the Beginning corner containing four hundred acres to the same more or less being granted by a patent to William Stringer bearing date the eighteenth day of January Anno thousand seven hundred and nine ty seven and conveyed from me William Stringer to Benjamin Meritt together with all and singular the aforesaid members and hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging and in appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto said Benjamin Meritt his heirs and assigns forever and do hereby bind myself my heirs and executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Benjamin Meritt his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns and from every other person laying any lawful claim to the said premises under or near them in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year first above written signed sealed and delivered in the presence of

332 The following act of Conveyance from Robert Goodlett to William Goodlett being proven before David Goodlett Esq^r by the oath of Henry Pinckney was presented and Recorded this 22nd day of August 1799

Know all men by these presents that I Robert Goodlett of S^d County for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars in hand paid by William Goodlett of S^d county the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold & released by these presents to Grant bargain & sell unto the said Wm Goodlett two hundred and seventeen acres of land it being part of two tracts originally granted to the said Robert Goodlett on the 5th of March 1790 lying & being in said County on the Branches of the middle fork of Tygar also the other tract was granted to S^d Robert Goodlett on the seventh day of March 1790 lying ~~old~~ ^{new} between Hammels Beaverdam of the middle fork of Tygar river so running each other Beginning at a post oak thence N 21^W 30 chain to a post oak on the corner of Benjamin Redstones land thence S 55^W 27 chain 30 links to a white oak thence N 28^W 9 chain to a black oak thence N 50^W 9 chain to a hickory thence S 50^W 22 chain to a hickory thence S 26^W 69 chain to a Stake on Micah Kingtons line thence along said line to a corner thence along his line until it meets a marked line that is the line of one hundred acres that was conveyed to William Wood by S^d Robert Goodlett which said line leads to the beginning corner including two hundred and seventeen acres being the same more or less together with all buildings the right members & appurtenances therof appertaining to said premises I have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Goodlett his heirs & assigns forever against myself my heirs & assigns and against all persons claiming under or by me forever In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 6th July Anno thousand seven hundred and ninety nine.
