sum of One hundred & fifty Dollars to me paid by Jordan Holcombe
of the state and County afores^d I grant Bargained sold and
Released unto the sd Jordan Holcombe a plantation or Tract of Land
lying & being in Greenville County & State afores^d Beginning on
a Point agreed Corner between the Thinekin Holcombe Tract
Bates thene to a marked Beach on the Creek called Bratons fork of
tiger River thence on to a stake Corner thene along the original
line to a stake thene a croft the Creek to a Spanish Oak on the
top of a Hill thene onto a stake on the original line thene a
long the old line of Lynch to the beginning Supposed to be
Sixty acres of Land be the same more or less the same being
part of a tract of Land granted to W^m Davis & by W^m Davis
Conveyed to John Davidson then John Davidson Conveyed the afores
mentioned part to the said Thinekin Holcombe. Together with
all and singularly the rights members hereditaments &
appertaining to the same premises belonging or in any wise
pertaining to have and to hold all and singularly the
premises before mentioned unto the sd Jordan Holcombe his
heirs and assigns forever and to whom by being myself my

375 The following deed of Conveyance from Oulton Goodman To
William Anderson being proven before Reuben Barnett Esq^r by the
oath of Epheth West was presented & Recorded this 21st day of December 1779
This Indenture made the Twenty fifth day of September one thousand
seven hundred and ninety nine Oulton Goodman & Mary his wife
of the one part & William Anderson of the State of Carolina
& Greenville County of the other part witnesseth that for and
in consideration of the sum of Four hundred & Fifty Dollars to me
the sd Goodman in hand paid by the sd Anderson and the Receipt
whereof is here by fully acknowledged by the sd Goodman fully
satisfied for the same I have Bargained sold all and confirmed
unto the sd William Anderson a plantation or tract of land by
Two hundred acres more or less it being the lower half of a four
hundred acre Tract of Land Granted unto Archibald Dill
by a Grant bearing date the first day of January in the year
seven hundred and eighty six & by sd Dill Conveyed unto John
Rufus & Sulley Rufus wife to sd John Rufus Conveyed to John
Standford from sd Standford to sd Oulton Goodman this is bounded
as follows beginning on a Red Oak Corner on Henry Prince's
line running N^o 30 W. 53¹/₂ chain to a Red Oak thence S^o 60 E. to
Red Oak a grader Major Gowen & James Cope land where the sd
Tract was Divided running thru a long s^d agreed line which
runs at or nears s^d Cope lands fence to a nail on Chestnut from
thence down s^d Creek first on one side and then the other to the
beginning corner. Together with all and singular the premises

Anderson his heirs & assigns forever we hereby bind our
