of one tract of Land on the sink hole fork of tiger River ori-  
ginally granted to the said Thomas Benson the twenty sixth day  
of January One thousand seven hundred and eighty five by his  
Excellency Benjamin Guard Esq<sup>r</sup> Beginning at a Red oak  
the beginning corner of the original survey thence S<sup>o</sup> 31 Chain  
62 links to a Red oak thence E 31 Chain 62 links to a Stake  
thence N 31 Chain 62 Links to a stake thence west 31 chain  
62 Links to the beginning it containing one hundred acres
