

belonging or appertaining; to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James West his heirs & assigns for ever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said James West his heirs and assigns for ever against myself & my heirs and against all and every other Person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, In Witness whereof I the said Jordan Jones have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 15 day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and three, and in the twenty eighth Year of American Independence —  sealed & delivered in
