This Indenture made the 6th July 1797 — In the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven between George Underwood & Sarah Underwood of the County of Greenville & State of South Carolina of the one part and Mr^s Fowler of the aforesaid State & County of the other part witnesseth that the s^r George Underwood & Sarah Underwood for and in consideration of the sum of pounds sterlings money to them in hand paid by the s^r Mr^s Fowler the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the s^r George Underwood & Sarah Underwood hath bargained & sold & by these presents doth bargain & sell unto the s^r Mr^s Fowler a certain tract or piece of land lying & being in Greenville County State of South Carolina on branch creek of river containing one hundred and seventy acres
