to me in hand paid by Robert Bolling of the State and District aforesaid, HAVE Granted  
bargained sold & Released and by these presents Do Grant bargain sell & release unto the  
said Robert Bolling all that plantation or tract of Land Containing two hundred and  
sixty two acres ( be the same more or less ) situated in Greenville District lying on horse  
Creek waters of Reedy River Beginning on a white Oak st turning thence N<sup>o</sup>. 93 E. 58.  
Chains on Stake & Sullivan's line to a white Oak st. three East 8 chains on said Sullivan's  
line to a post Oak st N<sup>o</sup>. 15 E. 7<sup>th</sup> 50 links to a post Oak st on the aforesaid Sullivan's line  
thence N<sup>o</sup>. 63 W. 27 Ch<sup>r</sup> on Hudson Berry's Line to a Stake st. thence N<sup>o</sup>. 73 W. 25 chains  
on said Berry's line to a Stake st thence S. 58 W. 31 Ch<sup>r</sup> on Benjamin Townsman's line  
thence S. 58 W. 31 Ch<sup>r</sup> down the meanders of said Creek a black Oak near the road thence  
along the said Benj<sup>a</sup> Townsman's line to a black oak st and thence down the meanders of said Creek to  
the beginning
