bargained & sold and by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the said Patten  
Ervin & Cleveland all the aforesaid Lot House & appurtenances aforesaid Together with all  
and singular the rights, members, Inheritances & appurtenances whatsoever to the said Lot  
Belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining thereto. And the cessions & Concessions remainder & rem-  
ainders unto Issues & profits thereof & of every part and parcel thereof, unto the said Patten  
Ervin & Cleveland their heirs & assigns forever To Have and To Hold the said lot N<sup>o</sup>. 36  
and appurtenances to said Patten Ervin & Cleveland their heirs & assigns & to their & every of their
