Page 549 then conveyed Around to said Linvill now from said Linvill to said Mercy Part of the tract situated in the District aforesaid on the waters of Horse Creek. Beginning on a Red Oak running thence S. 55 E. 34 Ch. to a pine thence S 70 W. 30^{ch} 50 W. on Benj. Browns line to a Red oak thence N. 30. 70 to a Spanish oak, thence to the beginning including Sixty Acres, more or less, together with all and singular the Rights members here detaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining. To have and To hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Warren Mafsey his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the sd. premises unto unto the said Warren Mafsey his heirs and assigns Against ourselves and our heirs and against every other Person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
