The State of South Carolina ³⁶⁴ Know all men by these Presents that I Josiah Cobb of the District of Greenville in the State aforesaid Farmer: in consideration of Two hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Noah Cobb of the District State aforesaid Blacksmith. Have Granted bargained sold and released and by these Presents Do Grant Bargain sell and release unto the said Noah Cobb all that part of a tract of two hundred acres of Land, lying in the Dist. Aforegⁿ on the waters of Mountain creek originally granted to Richard Brown (Deceased) By His Excellency William Moultrie on the fourth day of December 1786. Reference being had to his will more fully appears as to that part of said tract. Beginning on a no Oak 348 Running N.W. 40° 39' to a Stake & thence S.W. 110.15° 31 lac black oak 34 thence S.E. 10° 15' to a stake & thence S.E. 78° 24' - 85 to a Stake & thence N.E. 20° 23' to the Beginning containing one hundred and two acres. Together with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments, and appurtenances to the said Premises Belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining. To have and To Hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Noah Cobb his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and Singular the said Premises unto the said Noah Cobb his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs & against every other Person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand & Seal this day of one thousand and eight hundred and six and in the twenty ninth year of the Independance of the United States of America
