of Greenville District in the State afores^d for and in Consideration of Three hundred
dollar to me in hand paid by Nathaniel Walker of the State & District afores^d. I HAD
Granted bargained sold and by these Presents doth grant bargain sell and Release unto the
said Nathaniel Walker all that tract or Parcels of Land containing Three hundred acres -
it being apart of a tract of one Thousand acres originally granted to Benjamin Kilgore
Jun^r on the third day of September in the Year 1792 and Recorded in Grant book F^r
N^r 5 Page 149. Situate in the State and District aforesaid between Rocky and Peters creek waters
of three rivers. Beginning at a Stake corner on the original line there running on the said Line
S. 71^o W. 39 ch^r to Stake corner on Isaac Rivers line, thence on said line N. 60 E. 14. 50 to stake
or made for John McHaffy thence on said line N. 5. 16 E. 9. ch^r to pine corner thence N. 40. W. 87.
ch^r to red oak C^r thence N. 78. W. 14 ch^r red oak corner thence due East 200ft. to Stake
C^r on John Hutchens line thence on said line S. 40. E. 13 ch^r to red C^r thence on S^r Hutchens
line N. 85. E. 8. 50 to Post 6 oak C^r thence due East on a marked line through said
tract 30. 50 to a gum corner thence S. 15. E. on marked line 50. 50 to a Stake the
Beginning C^r - which include the full quantity of three hundred acres - Together
with all and singulars the rights members dividends and appurtenances therunto
belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining - therunto and I the said James
Kilgore do bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to forever warrant and defend the
above described premises as aforesaid to the only person or persons whom he or
Nathaniel Walker his heirs Executors adm^r and assigns against myself my heirs
adm^r &c. and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to
claim the same or any part thereof - Witness my hand at Greenville this twenty ninth
day of Oct^r one thousand eight hundred and fourty six in the twenty ninth year of
the Independence of the United States of America -
