Know all men by these presents that I Benjamin West of the State of South Carolina & District of Greenville for & in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and Fifty dollars to me in hand paid by James Benson of the State of District afores<sup>d</sup> — Have granted bargained sold and Released unto the afores<sup>d</sup> James Benson a plantation a tract of Land lying in the district afores<sup>d</sup> on both sides of Tygar River on which said West now lives — Beginning on a white Oak corner of Rays theme to a pine of said Benson's land thence to a red Oak of 11<sup>ft</sup> 6<sup>in</sup> Pine theme Salmon line go left theme crossing the river to the Waggon road & theme up the said road to a line between Whealy & Stewards to rays South the post oak corner theme to the beginning corner Containing one hundred and twenty five acres more or less. — Together with all the rights and appurtenance to have and to hold all the premises before mentioned unto the said James Benson his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors Administrators & assigns to warrant and forever defend the aforesaid premises against all Person or Persons in any wise claiming the said premises or any part thereof = In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this seventeenth day of November Eighteen hundred and five & in the presence of us the witnesses — Benjamin West
