KNOW all men by these presents that I William Tinsley of Greenville Dist. & State of
Carolina for & in consideration of the sum of forty Dollars to him in hand paid by John
Sammon of the same Dist. & State afores^t the Receipt whereof he the said William Tinsley
doth hereby acknowledge. That bargained sold released & confirmed unto the said
Sammon his heirs & assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying &
being in the district afores^t on the water of Reedy River containing twenty acres more or
less, & bounded as followeth (viz.) Beginning on a hickory on Sammons line thence
Sammons line S^c to a hickory corner on Wm Duncans line, thence W^c to a branch
thence down the branch as it meanders to a hickory & chestnut tree thence a new
line N^c to the beginning. To have and to hold the above said land & premises with
all and singular the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging & in any
wise appertaining to him the said Sammon his heirs and assigns forever to the only
proper use and behoof of him the said John Sammon his heirs and assigns
forever to have and to occupy, possess & enjoy the same with every part thereof
to him the said Sammon his heirs and assigns forever against any claim or demand
of me or my heirs or against the lawful claim of any other person whatsoever -
shall do & will warrant & defend. In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seals this Eleventh day of November Eighteen hundred
