 Eighty five, and duly recorded in the Secretaries office said Land laying on both sides of
 the South fork of Musch creek, Together with all the Profits and appurtenances whatsoever
 thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining and all the Estate Right titles claims and
 demands whatsoever of him the said Angus McAllister or in and to. Together the said
 tract of lands and Premises above mentioned and every Part and Parcel thereof to
 the only use and behoof of him the said John Stanford forever: and the said Angus
 McAllister for himself and his heirs and against every of them unto the said John
 Stanford his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant from all other Persons lawfully

 or Parcel of Land containing Eighty Acres by Estimation (the same more or less)
 Situate in Greenville District, on both sides of the South Fork of Musch creek waters of Tyger
 and runs as follows viz: Beginning on a red oak on the south side of said Fork thence North
 Eighty two degrees West to a stake on the said South Fork thence down the Meadow of said Fork to a
 Spanish oak on the north bank of said Fork thence North twenty eight degrees West to a white
 oak on the orchard branch thence down the said Branch to Boddens line thence with
 said line to Sherrills line thence Sherrills line to Easter Thomas's State corner thence
 South Eight degrees west fifty chains to the Beginning. Together with all the Lingers
