Moore his heirs and assigns forever, to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Robt. H. Moore his heirs & assigns forever. To have to hold use occupy possess & enjoy the same with every part or parcel thereof unto him the said Robt. H. Moore his heirs & assigns forever, against me the said Joshua Hawkins or my heirs & against the lawful claim
