Carolina Know all men by these presents that I John Vickery of the State aforesaid and district of Pendleton in Consideration of the sum of Twenty four dollars to me paid by Thomas Dean of the State aforesaid and district of Greenville have granted bargained & released and by these presents do grant Bargain Sell and Release unto the sd Thomas Dean a tract or parcel of Land containing Seventy acres more or less Situate in the district of Greenville on the south side of the middle fork of the Reedy River beginning at a post oak standing on the Original line of Land granted to Jacob Wallander Jones it being the corner of a part of the same tract conveyed by the P. Vickery to Benjamin Armstrong Runing thence S.W. 40:42:50: to a post oak corner thence S.E. 30: 11: 50: to James Hawks line to a stake thence N.E. on a stone fence line to a post oak made by the sd Hawks Dean & John Simmons separating of a part of the tract conveyed to the sd Hawks Dean by the before mentioned John Simmons from thence on a Conditional line of mark & trees to a stake to where a second conditional line of mark begins it leading from the beginning corner separating of Armstrong's Land it being a part of a tract originally granted to James Harrison and signed by this Ex Gentry William mouthree on the second day of December one thousand seven hundred and thirty three the above bounds including Seventy acres more or less with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the sd premises belonging or in any wise Incident or pertaining to have and to hold all and Singularly the premises before mentioned unto the sd Thomas Dean his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors administrators and assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mention ed unto the sd Thomas Dean his heirs and assigns against my self my heirs and assigns and all and every other person or persons whatsoever laying any claim to apart or parts thereof in witness whereof I do hereunto set my hand and seal this 16 day of March one thousand eight hundred and Seven.
