Districts of Spartanburg and Greenville and on the south side of S^o Tygar River
being a part of large survey originally granted to John Thomas Jun^r Conveyed by
him to said Walker the rights hereof - Together with all hereditaments and
appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining
thereto. To have and To hold all as a singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said James Beck his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself
my heirs, Executors or administrators to warrant and forever defend all & singular
the said premises unto the said James Beck his heirs and assigns against myself
