executors Administrators and assigns against myself my heirs executors and administrators and  
against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim  
the said Negro man Daniel. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my  
hand and affix'd my seal this 11<sup>th</sup> day of March 1807 -
