



South Carolina This Indenture made the second day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seven, Between Abner Underwood & Thomas Green of Greenville District of the one part. & John Baylis Earl Elkin of said District of the other part. Witnesseth Whereas Abner Underwood & Thomas Green by their notes or obligations bearing even date with these presents stand bound to the said John Baylis Earl Elkin and to his heirs in the sum of Eighteen hundred Dollars the first note of six hundred Dollars payable 25th Decr 1807. the second note six hundred Dollars payable 25th Decr 1808. the third note payable the 25th day of Decr 1809 Now this Indenture witnesseth that the said Abner Underwood & Thomas Green for and in consideration of the said debt or sum of eighteen hundred Dollars payable as aforesaid to the said John Baylis Earl Elkin, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the three above mentioned notes of six hundred Dollars each and also in consideration of three thousand Dollars by him the said John Baylis Earl Elkin to the said Abner Underwood & Thomas Green in hand paid at & before the sealing and delivery of these presents - Doth Grant Bargain sell alien Release Convey
