I Hugh McCay Sen<sup>t</sup> of the one part for and in consideration of six hundred Dollars to me in hand  
Paid, Have granted bargained & sold unto Moses Swafford a certain tract of land, containing two  
hundred acres more or less, lying in the District aforesaid, on a branch of Muskeet creek, being part of  
a tract of land granted to John Portman and hath such shapes farms & marks and bound as a  
plat thereunto annex<sup>t</sup> represents and Recorded in Secretaries office in grant book J<sup>d</sup> 13.  
Beginning on a Stake on John Nicolls line running thence S.E. to a white oak thence S.E. to a Stake on  
the original line thence S. to a post oak thence with the original to the Beginning. also another  
tract of land, Beginning on a post oak, on the above mentioned land running N.W. to a black oak S.W.  
to a post oak, E. to a red oak thence S.E. to a Stake <sup>thence</sup> E. to two turkey oaks on land laid out for  
Charter in thence N.W. along said line to a post oak on the above mentioned two hundred acres  
S.W. along s<sup>e</sup> line to the Beginning; the same containing one hundred & Seventy two acres more or less  
which may fully appear by the plat & Grant, represents & Recorded in grant book L No 5 page 333.  
also Eighteen acres more or less. Joining the above mentioned land part of a tract of lands granted to  
John Nicolls. Beginning on a post oak thence to a black oak, thence along a conditional line  
to a sweet gison on spring branch thence up said branch to an ash thence along s<sup>e</sup> Nicolls  
line to the Beginning. I the said Hugh McCay Sen<sup>t</sup> do warrant and forever defend the above  
tracts of land unto the said Moses Swafford & his heirs forever free & clear from me & my heirs and
