of Greenville district State aforesaid, for & in consideration of two hundred & fifty dollars
paid by James G. Gray in Greenville district and State of South Carolina, & have
bargained granted sold & Released, and by these presents do bargain grant sell
and Release unto the S: Jas G. Gray all that tract plantation or parcel of land
supposed to contain one hundred acres be the same more or less, situate on a branch
of beaverdam creek of south Tygar river, Beginning on a black oak on the north side of the
branch thence a straight line to a hickory, thence N.W. to a black oak, at the head
of a branch thence N.E. to a black oak stake on John Sparks's line thence along Sparks
line to a hickory thence along Gilbreath's line to a maple, thence along S: Geo. Gilbreath's
line to a pine stake, thence down to a spring branch of R. Carter's line thence down the said
branch to a white oak, thence a straight line to a maple in a small Branch
thence down the so branch to the main branch that runs through the plantation
thence up the branch to the Beginning. Together with all & singular the
right members hereditaments and appurtenancy thereto belonging or in
any wise incident or appertaining thereto, to have and to hold all and
singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Jas G. Gray his heirs
and assigns forever, and I hereby bind myself my heirs Execs & adms
to warrant and forever defend all & singular the said premises unto
the said J. G. Gray his heirs & assigns, against myself and my heirs, &
against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim
the same or any part thereof, Witness my hand and seal this 28th
day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and six, signed sealed and delivered in presence
