These Indentures Made this twenty-fourth day of October 1804: Between William Reed
of the State of South Carolina Greenville District of the one part, and Robert Clark of
the State and District aforesaid, of the other part. Witnesseth that the said William
Reed for and in consideration of 150 Dollars to him in hand paid by the said
Robert Clark the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, that the said William Reed
hath bargained, and by these presents doth bargain sell and Conferm unto Robert
Clark forever, all that tract or parcel of land containing one hundred acres. It
being a part of a tract of 320 acres originally granted to Joseph Reed by Pattern bearing
date the 7th day of May 1792. Recorded in grant book E. v. 5. Page 308. the land to be conveyed
begins as follows. W^e Beginning at a post oak 31. om from the original tract & runs N. 70. E.
38.50. on the old line to a red oak bush, from thence N. 20. W. through the S. tract 40:
chains to a red oak & new marker on a waggon road, thence S. 70. W. 16 Ch. to a Stake &
on the original line thence on S. line 19. Ch. to a Stake 31 om thence S. 70. W. 16.50 to a
black oak 31 om. thence S. 20. E. 20.50. to the Beginning post & 31 om, Which land with
all its appurtenances rents profits and commodities whatsoever, or in any wise afftaining
thereto. the s^rd William Reed doth covenant and agree that he will forever warrant
and defend the above tract of land with every part of the afores^d appurtenances from himself
his heirs Executors & Administr^s or any other person or persons laying any just or lawful
claim thereto or any part thereof, but to the proper use & behoof of him the said
Robert Clark his heirs Executors Administr^s and signing forever. As Witness where
the said William Reed hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal this day and
