

Now This Indenture witnesseth that I William Anderson the then Sheriff  
 of the district aforesaid, in obedience of, and pursuant to the order of Court aforesaid  
 and the act of the General Assembly of the said State in such case made & provided  
 did advertise publish and sell, All that tract or parcel of land late the property of  
 the said Millington Eastley Deceased, the widow's dower as laid off by the said Commissioner  
 excepting unto May John Blafingame for the sum of eight hundred and Sixty dollars  
 he at that price or sum being the highest and last bidder according to the customs  
 of vendues, which said land is situate lying and being on Saluda river in the district  
 and State aforesaid, and containing exclusive of the widow's dower aforesaid, as appears  
 by a plat thereof, made out under the direction of the said Commissioner, a  
 copy of which is hereunto annexed, four hundred and Eighty acres, be the same  
 more or less, Beginning at a Stake corner on the river running thence N 65 E 81 chain  
 to a Stake thence S 45 E 37 30 to a Spanish oak, thence S 43 W 20 ch 50 links to a white  
 oak, thence S 50 E one chain to a Stake on the branch, thence down the meanders of  
 the said branch, to a Stake corner being the upper corner of the widow's dower, thence N  
 55 W 20 ch 50 links to Post oak, marked on said Plat B, thence S 52 W 30 chain to a  
 red oak, marked on said plat C thence S 4 E 44 ch 875 links to a red oak marked  
 on said plat D at the mouth of the aforesaid branch or creek where it empties into the river  
 thence up the meander of the said river to the beginning. Together with all and singular  
 the right members hereditament and appurtenancy to the said Premises belonging any  
 way incident or pertaining. To Have and to Hold all and singular the premises before  
 mentioned unto the said John Blafingame his heirs & assigns forever and I do hereby  
 bind myself my heirs & executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all  
 and singular the premises before mentioned, the widow's dower as already laid off  
 by the Commissioner and designated on the said plat excepting unto the said John  
 Blafingame his heirs and assigns, against the lawfull claim or claim of any other  
 Person or Persons whomsoever. - In Witness whereof I the said William Anderson
