

State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents that I James Givens  
of Greenville District in consideration of the sum of one hundred and Sixty  
dollars to me paid by John Cochran of Greenville district State aforesaid -  
Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant  
bargained sell and release unto the said John Cochran a plantation or tract  
of land, laying and being in Greenville district on Green Creek of South  
Pacoller River, Beginning at a Hickory of Commonly Survey on the west side of the  
Creek running thence S. 30° E. 24 ch. 20 lls. to a chestnut thence R. 28. E. 10 ch. 25 lls.  
to a stake on our agreed line, thence N. 60° E. 25 ch. to a chestnut crooked green  
Creek, thence N. 30° W. 10 ch. 25 lls. to a chestnut Thomas Maxwell corner, thence N. 70°  
W. 12 ch. 25 lls. to a Black oak, thence N. 35° W. 25 ch. to a chestnut oak, thence  
S. 55° W. crossing the creek 25 ch. to a Stake, thence to the Beginning -  
Containing by estimation Ninety eight acres, be the same more or less, being part of  
Three tracts or parcels of land, one tract surveyed for Duncan Campbell and  
Patent date 5<sup>th</sup> day June 1786. and a part of the same sold and conveyed by him to  
Joseph Maxwell & by him & Maxwell conveyed to James Fowler, one other tract  
surveyed for Thomas Maxwell and patent bearing date 4<sup>th</sup> April 1788. adjoining the  
above and a part of the same sold and conveyed by him to Joseph Maxwell and by  
him conveyed to James Fowler and by him to me, also one other tract surveyed for  
Joseph Maxwell of patent bearing date 5<sup>th</sup> December 1791. adjoining the above  
land, and a part of the same sold and conveyed by him to James Fowler and  
by him to me, which three parcels of Land constitute the above tract of Ninety eight  
acres, Together with all and singular the right members hereditaments and  
appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining. -  
To have and to Hold all and singular the s<sup>d</sup> premises before mentioned unto the s<sup>d</sup>  
John Cochran his heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself my heirs  
executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular  
the said premises unto the said John Cochran his heirs and assigns, against  
myself and my heirs, & against every Person whomever lawfully claiming or to claim  
the same or any part thereof - In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
and seal this 16<sup>th</sup> day of July 1806: and thirty first year of American Independence

his act and deed the within release unto John Cochran for the purpose
