of Greenville District for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and
sixty dollars to me paid by John Cochran of Greenville District State aforesaid,
I have granted bargained sold Released, and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and Release unto the said John Cochran a certain tract or Parcel of Land
laying and being in Greenville District on both sides of Greens Creek of South
Carolina River; Beginning at a Chesnut, a Station tree on a line of a survey made
for Duncan Campbell and running thence N. 35. W. to a Chesnut thence S. 53.
W. 13. E. to a Chesnut oak, thence N. 60. W. 22. E. to a Chesnut, thence S. 30.
W. 20. E. to a Stake, thence S. 53. E. to a Stake opposite to J. Givens Cross fence
and thence with the direction of said Cross fence N. 55. E. to the Beginning
Supposed to contain one hundred acres be the same more or less, being the upper
end of a survey made by Duncan Campbell bearing date by patent 5th day of
June 1785: and by them conveyed to Thomas & Joseph Maxwell, and by Joseph
Maxwell to John Gowen, and by him to me, including the plantation where I now live
Together with all and singular the rights members Hereditaments and
appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining -

To Have and To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the
said John Cochran and his heirs forever. I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors
and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said
premises unto the said John Cochran his heirs and assigns, against myself
and my heirs, and against every Person whomsoever lawfully claiming or
to claim the same or any part thereof. In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and Seal this 28th day of October A.D. 1808 one thousand eight
hundred and Eight, and thirty first year of American Independence -
