This Indenture made this 17th April 1807. Between Edward Howard of the State
of S. Carolina & District of Greenville of the one part, & Bennet Parish of the
State & District aforesaid of the other part, witnesseth that the s^r Edward Howard
for and in consideration of the sum of two pounds lawfull money to him in
hand paid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, hath bargained and
sold and by these presents doth bargain sell release and confirm unto Bennet
Parish forever all that plantation or tract of land containing one hundred acres
it being a part of a tract 337 acres originally granted to Edward Howard by patent
bearing Date 22nd January 1795. & Recorded in Grant Book A. K. 5 Page 179. Situate
in Greenville District & State aforesd. on the branches of Reycorns Creek, the
to be conveyed begins as follows, Viz, Beginning at a red oak st^t for v^e tract &
green N. 32 chaens to a post oak st^t thence S. 35^o to a pine st^t thence E. 32 to a Spanish
oak st^t thence N. 31 to the Beginning, red oak st^t, which includes the quantity of
land to be conveyed & the s^r Edward Howard doth covenant & agree to me with
the s^r Bennet Parish that he will forever warrant and defend the above
described one hundred acres of land from himself his heirs Executors
Administrators or assigns or any other person or persons laying, quest or
Lawfull right title or claim therunto or any part thereof, Together
with all singularly the appurtenancy hereditaments amoluments Commodities
Rents issues and profits therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining
therunto but to the only proper use behoof of him the said Bennet Parish &
his heirs Executors adm^t or assigns forever, In Witness whereof the s^r Edward
Howard hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and
date first above written, Signed Sealed and delivered in presence of
John Bruce
