This Indenture made the fifth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Eight, between John Blankinship of Greenville District and State aforesaid, Hatter, of the one part, and William Mathers Junior of the State of Ohio, Farmer, of the other part, Witnesseth. Whereas John Blankinship & William Blankinship by their two notes of hand bearing even date with these presents stand bound to the said William Mathers Junior and to his Heirs and assigns in the sum of four hundred and ten dollars & 50 cents Two hundred and ten dollars and fifty cents of the sum aforesaid to be paid on the 25<sup>th</sup> December 1809 the other two hundred dollars to be paid on or before the twenty fifth day of December which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & ten, with lawfull Interest on the whole, Now this Indenture witnesseth, that the said John Blankinship for and in consideration of the said debt or sum of four hundred & ten dollars & fifty cents, payable as aforesaid to the said William Mathers Junr, and for the better securing the payment thereof with interest to the said Wm Mathers Junr According to the note aforesaid, and also in consideration of the sum of ten cents by him the said William Mathers Junr to the said John Blankinship in Hand paid, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, Do Oth grant, bargain, sell, alien, release, convey and confirm unto the said William Mathers Junr and to his Heirs and assigns forever, All that Plantation tract or Parcel of land wherein I now live, Containing One hundred and fifty acres Situate lying and being in the District and State aforesaid on Saluda River, beginning at a White Oak on the river James Clayton, County
