of Land, containing one hundred & Sixty three acres be the same more or less, it being
the land whereon I now live, situate in Greenville District & joining on Reedy River
and bounded by lands belonging to the following persons, to wit, by Benjamin Pollard
land on the upper part thence by Summerlands thence by Gilkland thence by
