Know all men by these presents that I John Robinson of Bourbon County & State of Kentucky for and in consideration of Fifty Five dollars to me in hand paid by William Toney of the District of Greenville & State aforesaid. Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William Toney all that plantation or tract of Land lying and being in the State and District aforesaid. containing Two hundred acres lying on the long branch it being one half of a tract of Land originally granted to Esther Thomas & by her sole conveyed to Benjamin Perry being the upper half of said tract. Beginning at a post oak on the north side of the long branch running thence S. 45. W 36 chains & 30 links to a post oak to said tract thence S. 45. E 44 Chains 29 links to a supposed corner thence N. 45. E 46. Ch. 30 links to a supposed corner thence N. 44 W. to the beginning. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To Have and To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Toney his heirs and assigns forever. and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors adm<sup>r</sup> and assigns to warrant and favor defend the said premises unto the said William Toney his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs and against every other Person or Persons whomsoever Lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this 12<sup>th</sup> day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and nine & the thirty third year of American Independence
