Five hundred Dollars to me paid by James Sanders Guignard of Columbia & Gabriel
Benson of Spartanburg in the State aforesaid, Gentlemen, have granted bargained
sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said
James S. Guignard & Gabriel Benson all that plantation or tract of land containing
one thousand acres more or less, situate in Greenville District on Mather's Creek
of the South fork of Saluda River bounded North east by land surveyed for William
Benson, all other sides vacant (originally surveyed for Robert Nash, the 2^d day
of August 1793) and granted to said Jacob S. Faust by his Excellency John Drayton
Governor &c. on the second day of March Anno Domini 1801. Together with all and
singular the rights, members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging
or in any wise incident or appertaining. To Have and To Hold all and singular the
premises before mentioned unto the said James S. Guignard & Gabriel Benson their heirs and
assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant
and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said James S. Guignard
and Gabriel Benson their heirs and assigns against myself my heirs lawfully claiming or to claim the same
or any part thereof. Witness my hand & seal this fifth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred & three -
