

The State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents that I Waddy Thompson
of Greenville District, in the State aforesaid, Esquire for and in consideration of the sum of
five hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by John Gordon of the State of Virginia and Danes-
burg County, Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents
do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Gordon Part of a certain
tract or parcel of land supposed to contain four hundred acres more or less, lying,
and being in the district aforesaid, on the waters of Saluda River, Beginning on a red
oak, running thence N. 85° to a post oak corner, thence East about 35 or 40 to the wa-
ter, along Bradfords line to the old original line thence along the original line to
the Beginning. Together with all and singular the rights, members hereof, tenements
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appur-
tenancing. To have & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the
said John Gordon his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my
heirs executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular
the said premises unto the said John Gordon his heirs and assigns against myself
and my heirs, and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming
or to claim the same or any part thereof, Witness my hand and seal this Eleventh
day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and
Eighty Nine, & in the thirty fourth year of American Independence Signed Sealed
