Thomas Howard & Aaron Swafford both of the State and District aforesaid
Witnesseth that the said Thomas Howard for and in consideration of
Three hundred dollars to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged, the s^rd Thomas Howard hath bargained sold and released unto
the said Aaron Swafford fifty acres of land more or less Situated on the
South Side of Tyger River in the district aforesaid, bounding on the widow Langford,
with reference to a deed from William Few to s^rd Howard also Twenty
acres more or less adjoining the above mentioned land Beginning at Peter
Howard's corner, on post oak running on said Howard's line, to a stake thence on
a conditional line to a stake on the widow Langford's line, thence to the
Beginning with reference to a deed from Jacob Swafford to s^rd Howard another
tract or parcel of land containing fifty acres more or less adjoining the above
mentioned land being a part of tract granted to Nicholas Jesper Beginning at
a Post oak corner thence to a black oak on the line thence to a Hickory on the
river, thence as the river runs to the line thence to the Beginning, reference to a
deed from Peter Howard to said Thomas Howard, in all one thousand and
Twenty acres more or less by these presents the said Thomas Howard doth bind
himself his heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant and forever defend that over
one hundred and Twenty acres of land more or less, with all its rights and
hereditaments unto s^rd Aaron Swafford his heirs and assigns forever against
all claims whatsoever or in any wise lawfully claiming said land In Witness
whereof the s^rd Thomas Howard hath set his hand and affixed his seal the
day and date above written, signed sealed and delivered in presence of us
John Wood, William Ford, Thomas Howard Seal
Greenville District. Personally came John Wood before me and made oath
as the law directs that he was present and saw Thomas Howard sign seal and
deliver the within deed to and for the use and purpose in it mentioned and that
he himself and W^m Ford was subscribing witness to the due execution of
