Hicks of State and District aforesaid, Have granted and sold and by these presents do grant bargain & sell to the s^d. Sam^l. Hicks part of a plantation or tract of Land lying & being in the district and State aforesaid, on the head of the Reddy fork it being part of a tract originally granted to J^{es}. Moody by his Excellency Thomas Pinckney in the year 1788. the Land to be conveyed Beginning on the trail road on a P. oak 37. running N. 20 E. 7. 90 to a black Jack, N. 65 E. 33. 14 to a P. oak, thence S. 45. E. 23. 50 to a post oak thence S. 20 W. on Jacobs black line to a maple stump, thence on a conditional line suposed near the s^d. - comes to Seabornes line, thence on said line to a stake on the Road thence on said Road, a conditional to the Beginning. Including one hundred and forty one acres more or less Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the s^d. premises belonging or in any wise appertaining or Incident to. Do Have and do Hold all and singular to the s^d. Sam^l. Hicks & I the s^d. Noel Wade do hereby bind myself my heirs & assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned to the said Sam^l. Hicks his heirs & assigns
